# Growing through **change**

The Spirit of Enterprise Awards honours companies that have persevered and flourished despite the odds

To survive in a digital-led era, businesses need to focus on growth and sustainability — buzzwords SOE president Saat Ismail (right) says that small and medium-sized enterprises have always been a huge part of the Singapore economy, but the primary challenge for many of these emerging companies is growing and staying competitive in this period of pervasive change.

"Our economy is currently facing three major shifts: the shift in global economic weight to Asia, the emergence of new technologies, and our demographic transition," he explains. "These open up opportunities, but also demand a

"These open up opportunities, but also demand a new mindset from businesses — to embrace innovation, build deep capabilities, and implement sustainable practices — the qualities we seek to highlight and celebrate in this year's batch of honourees."

### Innovation and grit

Held annually, the SOE Awards recognises noteworthy achievements in Singapore's entrepreneurial scene.

In addition to the 32 honourees from 28 companies, one particularly outstanding entrepreneur receives the SOE-Nexia TS Entrepreneur of the Year award.

The top honour this year goes to Mr Thomas Fernandez, the founder chairman and chief executive officer of PestBusters.

Three start-ups have also been handed the SOE-Neo Start-Up Awards, which was introduced last year to put the spotlight on Singapore's most promising start-ups — which play an increasingly important role in Singapore's economy.

Says Mr Ismail: "We are impressed by the big ideas and disruptive thinking displayed by this year's winners. Beyond the traditional industry sectors, there is a growing number of enterprises filling up unexplored industry niches and meeting unmet demands."

For instance, Big Tiny is the first company in Singapore to integrate eco-tourism with the rising

trend of tiny homes, where city-dwelling holiday makers to Australia can rent a tiny home on wheels parked in a rural setting.

Another awardee, Motorist, is a third-party digital platform that facilitates transactions between direct buyers and sellers of motorised vehicles.

"These businesses are led by a fearless generation that believes in creating its own paths and seizing opportunities beyond true-and-tested formulas," Mr Ismail highlights.

### Inspiring the next generation

A new partnership with Temasek Polytechnic is set to ignite the entrepreneurial spirit among young people with closer collaborations, joint programmes and sharing of resources when it is launched.

For example, the upcoming SOE forums and start-up engagements will tap the polytechnic's expertise and resources in supporting the local start-up ecosystem.

At the same time, its students will be given the opportunity to experience the world of entrepreneurship beyond the classroom through a joint internship programme with SOE honourees, or by participating in the SOE Interviewer Programme.

Tertiary students will also get the opportunity to interview their entrepreneurial heroes. Those who submit the best transcripts will receive the SOE-Charles & Keith Best Student Interviewer Award.
